The Department for Work and Pensions (DWP) is responsible for welfare, pensions and child maintenance policy. As the UK's biggest public service department, it administers the State Pension and a range of working age, disability and ill health benefits to over 22 million claimants and customers. In 2005, Solution-Soft started working with Accenture to integrate Time Machine inside DWP's Pension Transformation Programme (PTP) project.

Challenges

The initial phase of the PTP project included many staff redundancies, which have been identified as a result of restructuring the organization and improvements in managing existing business processes.

However, these resource reductions caused problems with backlogs building in the centres, cases and important documents being lost. The changes to be introduced through the Pensions Transformation Programme, in particular the reduction in processes following the combination of State Pension and Pension Credit processing, were designed to reduce error and delay.

Time Machine Solution

DWP initially began using Time Machine in 2005 where they used Time Machine to test their Pensions Transformation Programme (PTP) project system deployment.

Iain Cavanagh, the projects Technical Support Lead from Accenture stated the following, "This (project) basically involves modernizing the Pension process and Time Machine is installed across our testing environments to allow us to 'spoof' system dates to allow cases to progress throughout their life cycle." This system deployment consisted of 14 licenses of Time Machine for Solaris.

Andrew Strain, Platforms & Infrastructure Service Delivery Lead, Accenture UK, added: "Not using Time Machine has created a huge mess in new implementations. For all new projects moving forward Time Machine will be used as a standard for our testing requirements, ultimately this will satisfy our clients' needs."

DWP continued using Time Machine in 2006 and 2007 for their PTP project.

In 2015, DWP migrated their datacenter from London to Newcastle and used TM as part of this migration. Shaun Lee Roberts, the Accenture DWP Development Architecture, said: "Time Machine a powerful enabler for testing time dependent logic in a controlled and more importantly safe manner. We sense a genuine desire from our account manager through to the support team to make our needs a priority. In the end it feels like they are an extension to our team."
